Things every hospital executive should know about their Inpatient Rehabilitation services

The lines between Post-Acute Care services are blurring!
Are you prepared for these changes?

- 1.** Bundled payment initiatives, site-neutral payments and Post-Acute Care (PAC) prospective payment systems (PPS) are changing the focus of care to a patient's episode of care versus where they received treatment. *Is your PAC continuum ready for the change?*
- 2.** Reimbursement, Regulatory and Clinical changes have changed where many orthopedic patients, especially joint replacements, receive their rehabilitation therapy. This is driving many patients away from Inpatient Rehabilitation Units to other levels of care. *Where are these patients receiving Post-Acute Care services in your market? Are you losing them to other providers?*
- 3.** Implementation of ICD-10 has compounded adherence to the 60% compliance rule. Certain discharges no longer qualify in the Inpatient Rehab Unit's compliance calculation. *Relying on historical projections can be misleading! Do you know how your unit measures up?*
- 4.** Inpatient Rehabilitation Facility Quality Reporting (IRF QRP) measures are in place and about to expand each year. *Is your unit compliant in submitting required data and ready to use the new care tool? It is a 2% penalty if not!*
